The UNIDO/KCG Conference "Developing Inclusive and Sustainable Global Value Chains in the Digital Age" is jointly organized by the Kiel Centre for Globalization (KCG) at the Kiel Institute for the World Economy (IfW) and the United Nations Industrial Development Organization (UNIDO). It builds on the Vienna Investment Conference: Quality FDI, Growth and Development which was jointly organized by UNIDO and IfW and held in September 2016 in Vienna.

It aims at bringing together academics, policy makers, representatives from international organizations and businesses to discuss the challenges and opportunities – and the possible future – of the proliferation of global production networks (GPNs). The focus is on how to make the most of global production sharing in the digital age and to ensure that GPNs are shaped in such a way as to foster "inclusive" and "sustainable" development of all countries involved.
